

Complete Setup for Raising Salmon

The following narrative will lead you through what is needed to have a successful experience raising salmon from eggs to releasing fry. Material costs were obtained from the internet on October 5, 2023 and may vary with time. Some of the items were currently “on sale.”

We have to emphasize that this information is a guide, and not a recommendation on which products to buy. Products highlighted in yellow are those that SIS-Seattle is currently purchasing for underserved schools that we serve.

The cost of setup from scratch will vary from \$1,200 to \$2,000 depending on the options made.

Equipment and supplies required to raise salmon is the school:

Chiller	Required to maintain temperature down to at least 47° F.
Pump	Required to circulate water through chiller. Note: earlier wand chillers do not require a pump, but these chillers are aging out.
Hoses	Attach the pump and chiller to the tank.
Tank	Recommend 55 gallon tank. Acrylic tanks are lighter than glass but are quite a bit more expensive.
Tank Stand	If the chiller is to be placed under the stand, you must allow for good air flow. The chiller can be placed next to the stand elevated off the floor to reduce dust collecting on the coils.
Filter	Filters can be cannisters placed outside the tank or hung on the back of the tank. Cannister filters provide better filtration and allow for more media variety. Cannister filters are more expensive.
Filter Media	Buy media for the type of filter that you have. This can include carbon, zeolite, porcelain and filter pads.
Aeration	Large enough to power two air stones. The aerator can be ac power only, but having an aerator with battery backup will provide air during power loss.
Air Stone	Several choices are available for air stones. Having at least one that includes a sponge filters will provide filtration when combined with a battery backup aerator.
